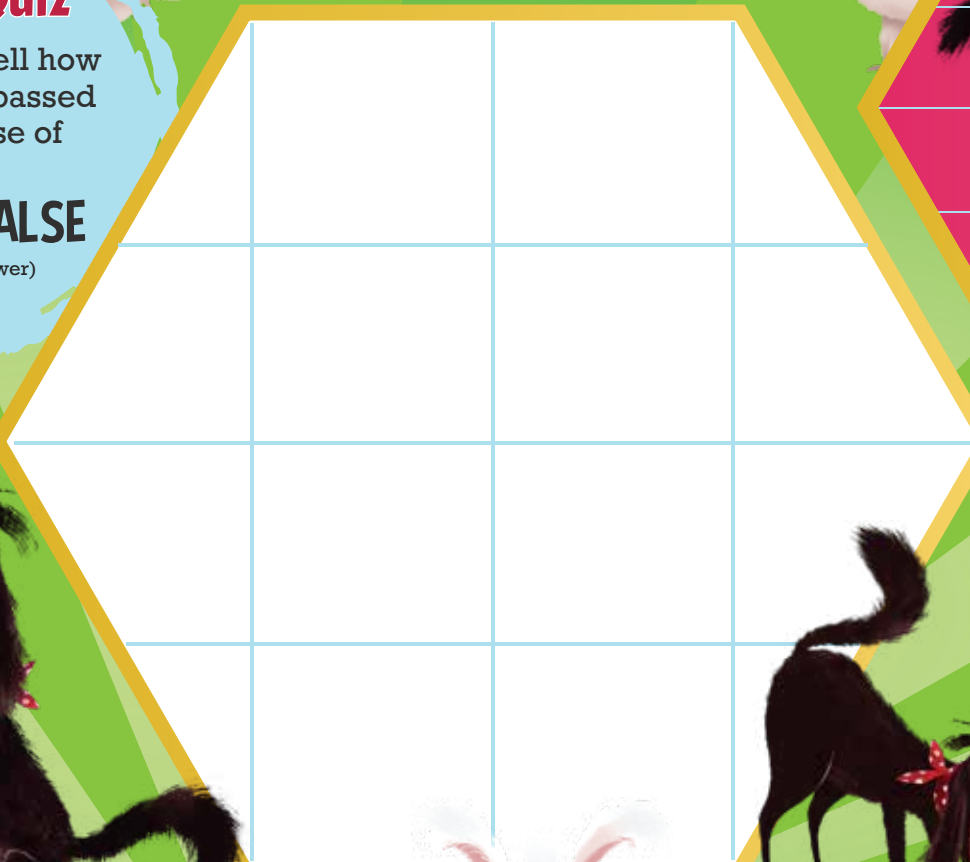

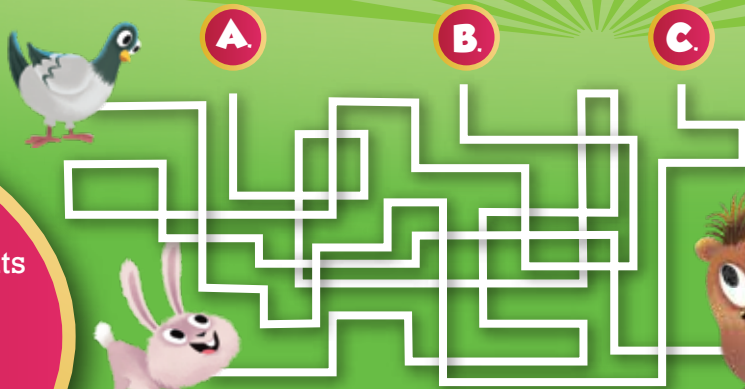

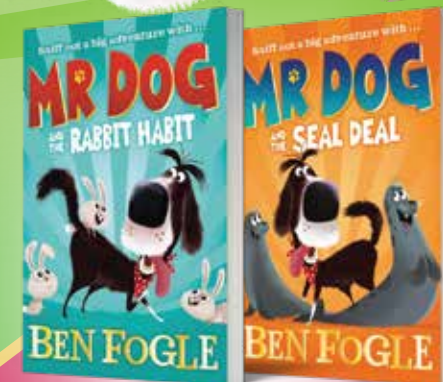

ANSWERS

- 1. TRUE - Dogs can detect the strength of a familiar smell. The weaker the smell the more time has passed.
- 2. TRUE - A dog's whiskers can feel small changes in the air around them so they can detect the size, shape and even speed of things nearby.
- 3. FALSE - Greyhounds can only reach speeds of up to 45 miles per hour.
